Established in 1927, Salesian College Sunbury has evolved from humble beginnings to be one of the pre-eminent education facilities in the outer Melbourne/Macedon Ranges area. As we are perfectly located in the Hume Corridor's Wider Northern Growth Region, we will see a dramatic population increase over the next 10-20 years.

To cater for this growth, Salesian College Sunbury is leading the way with innovative, contemporary, student-centred learning spaces. Some of the exciting projects include the Food Studies Centre (completed 2022), STEAM Centre (completed 2024), sporting precinct masterplan, sporting pavilion, substantial upgrades to infrastructure, Agricultural and Environmental Science Centre (which includes a multi-purpose produce shed for student/community engagement), and a Religious Education Hub to engage staff and students in our Catholic identity and Salesian Charism, all taking place while aiming to deliver a carbon neutral environment. With increasing student enrolments and high demand for a Salesian secondary education, we have commenced masterplanning for our second campus, which will be located nearby on our farmlands with an anticipated opening in 2028.

Unfortunately, the aforementioned projects do not come cheaply, and income from tuition fees alone cannot provide the financial basis for development. Therefore, Salesian College Sunbury relies on the generosity of its community to support its aims and help bring its long-term, student-focused goals to fruition.

FUNDRAISING








SUMMARY
