



2025 UNIFORM GUIDE

At Salesian College Sunbury, we strive to be a Faith Community committed to Excellence in Learning. The College Uniform is a visible symbol of the College and a public declaration of its values, standards and beliefs. It creates a sense of individual and collective pride in students and their identification with the College. It is a symbol of equality among students and demonstrates mutual respect. Wearing the uniform correctly is an expectation for all students enrolled at the College, and the following guidelines will assist in promoting a better climate of learning for all.

The school uniform draws attention to our College, and great care should be taken to ensure it is worn with pride and respect. When the uniform is neat and tidy, our visitors, parents and community view us with the warmest respect. People like seeing students presented as respectable and friendly. Our College uniform is practical, attractive and highlights our values and character.

The College expects students in uniform to be well-groomed at all times. If uniform needs repairing or is unavailable, an alternative should be worn and a signed note from a parent or guardian explaining why should be given to the student's Year Level Coordinator.

UNIFORM ITEMS

The uniform consists of (3) main aspects:

Summer uniform (Term 1 & 4) Winter uniform (Terms 2 & 3) Sports uniform (year round)

UNIFORM EXPECTATIONS | ALL STUDENTS

The College expects all students to be wearing a clean and neat uniform at all times and to be well-groomed. If a uniform item needs to be repaired or is unavailable, an alternate is to be worn and a signed note from a parent or guardian explaining the reason is be to given to the Year Level Leader in the morning (via the College Diary). Students in breach of uniform expectations will be asked to correct the issue, and/or be asked to stay at home until the issue is corrected.

COLLEGE BLAZER

The College blazer is to be worn to and from school every day.

PE UNIFORM

Only Savio Campus students (Years 7-10) are permitted to wear the Sports Uniform to/from school on days they have a scheduled PE class. Bosco Campus students are expected to bring their Sports Uniform to the College on days of scheduled PE lessons and get changed at school.

MIXING UNIFORM ITEMS

Uniform items from each of the (3) styles (ie. Summer, Winter, Sports) are not permitted to be interchanged. For example, Sports Uniform items (eg. Navy shell jacket) may not be worn with the Summer/Winter uniform.

EXCURSIONS

When representing the College at excursions, or travelling to and from the College, it is expected that students wear the entire uniform correctly. Refer to the Excursion permission slip for the uniform expectation.



SUMMER UNIFORM | TERMS 1 AND 4

DRESS

- College Blazer (compulsory all year)
- · College grey jumper and/or vest
- College dress (worn at knee length)
- College white or navy socks with grey & gold stripe
- College navy school bag
- Polished black lace up shoes (enclosed)*



WINTER UNIFORM | TERMS 2 AND 3

SKIRT

- College Blazer (compulsory all year)
- College grey jumper and/or vest
- · College long sleeve white shirt
- College kilt (worn at knee length)
- College navy tights or socks (navy or white)
- College navy school bag
- Polished black lace up shoes (enclosed)*



SHORTS/PANTS

- College Blazer (compulsory all year)
- · College grey jumper and/or vest
- College short or long sleeve white shirt
- College navy shorts or pants
- College white or navy socks with grey & gold stripe
- · College navy school bag
- Polished black lace up shoes (enclosed)*



PANTS

- College Blazer (compulsory all year)
- College grey jumper and/or vest
- College long sleeve white shirt
- College navy trousers
- College white or navy socks (grey & gold stripe)
- College tie (compulsory for boys only)
- College navy school bag
- Polished black lace up shoes (enclosed)*



Note: items with (*) can be purchased at retail outlets. All other uniform items can be purchased from the College Uniform Shop.

COLLEGE SPORT UNIFORM

Years 7 - 10 Savio Campus students may wear the entire HPE and Sports uniform to and from school on days they have a timetabled PE class. Alternatively, students may wear the correct College uniform and change into their HPE and Sports uniform at school prior to the PE class.

HPE AND SPORTS UNIFORM

- College navy soft shell jacket
- College house polo top (short or long sleeved)
- College shorts
- College tracksuit pants
- College cap
- College sports socks (white with navy & gold stripe)
- Sports runners (must provide suitable support and grip for a range of sports. They must also be non-marking *)



SPECIALTY ITEMS

AGRICULTURE

Students enrolled in Agriculture subjects are required to wear the uniform items as specified in the booklist. These are available from the uniform shop.

OPTIONAL ITEMS

RAINCOAT

The navy lined showerproof raincoat has a hood made with waterproof fabric that can be folded up into the collar. The raincoat can be worn to and from school only when it is raining. The raincoat is not to be worn at school or as a replacement to the blazer. No other raincoats/jackets are permitted.

SCARF

The College branded navy-blue scarf may be worn all year round. No other scarves are permitted to be worn.

BEANIE

The College navy & gold beanie is the only beanie permitted to be worn.

PERSONAL APPEARANCE | ALL STUDENTS

JEWELLERY

- · Students may wear only one small stud or sleeper per ear.
- Bracelets and rings are not permitted. Religious necklaces are permitted, but they must not be visible.
- Students wearing non-permitted items of jewellery will be asked to remove them (confiscated).
 Confiscated items will be held in a safe for the remainder of the school term. At the end of Term, items can be collected from Student Hub(s).

PIERCINGS AND TATTOOS

Students are not permitted to have any facial or tongue piercings at the College, including spacers. Visible tattoos are also not permitted. Students wearing a facial or tongue piercing will be asked to remove the item and they will be held in a safe for the remainder of the school term.

GROOMING AND MAKEUP

- Makeup is not permitted.
- Coloured nail polish and false nails are not permitted.
- Boys must be clean shaven (no beards, moustaches or long sideburns)

HAIRSTYLES

- Hair must be clean, neatly styled and natural in colour and be kept off the face, ears and collar.
 Accessories must be discreet, small and plain in colour.
- Hair length below the collar should be tied back or kept off the face with a band. No hair should fall across the face or cover the eyes or ears.
- Extreme hairstyles are not permitted (e.g. shaved hair less than number two blade, severe variations in hair length and/or colour).
- Hair must be natural in colour. Moderate and discrete variations in natural colour such as highlights, tips and streaks are permitted as long as the overall style is predominantly a single natural colour.

EXEMPTIONS TO STUDENT UNIFORM GUIDELINES

Salesian College Sunbury understands that individual circumstances may require adjustments to uniform guidelines. Students and their families can request exemptions in writing or in person to the Principal if:

- Religious, ethnic, or cultural beliefs (e.g., wearing a turban or jewellery) conflict with the dress code.
- · A disability or health condition requires uniform adjustments (medical documentation required).
- Economic hardship prevents compliance with the guidelines.

The Principal or delegate will assess requests, often meeting with the family to find a resolution, such as temporary exemptions or referrals to support services. If an exemption is denied, written reasons will be provided.
